Hence, she has requested for allotment of Engineering Assistants to RWS Dept. for effective implementation of several schemes such as Amruthadhara, Jal Jeevan Mission, Water Grid, NREGS, Naadu Nedu, etc, on permanent basis along with their establishment and service matters for better implementation of rural drinking water schemes.

The Engineer-in-Chief, PR is therefore requested to provide comprehensive details regarding the Engineering Assistants Gr.II including the total number of Engineering Assistants working in the State, any surplus, whether these posts were previously allocated to other departments, and any proposals or discussions held with the Director of the GSWS Department concerning this issue and further requested to furnish a report including the said details along with the remarks on the letter of ENC, RWS and relevant documents, to Govt. for taking further action in the matter.
