We, The Andhra Pradesh Rural Water Supply Engineers Association (APRWSEA), Vijayawada, humbly submits this request for the immediate deputation of 3 to 5 Engineer Assistants per mandal to the RWS&S Department to support AEE/AEs in the respective mandals. This request is crucial in light of the impending summer season and the escalating workload in the department.

As per Reference 1, we previously requested the permanent allotment of Engineer Assistants to the RWS&S Department. However, we understand that this process may take time. Therefore, considering the urgent operational requirements, we now request the temporary deputation of Engineer Assistants to the RWS&S Department to effectively manage the increasing workload and ensure uninterrupted rural water supply, especially during the summer season.

Necessity of Deputation of Engineering Assistants:

- 1. Summer Water Supply Crisis Management:
 - As temperatures rise, water scarcity issues are expected in many rural areas, requiring continuous monitoring and maintenance of water supply schemes and also transportation of drinking water.
 - Immediate intervention is necessary for monitoring transportation of drinking water, leak detection, pressure optimization, and pipeline repairs to prevent disruptions in the drinking water supply.
- 2. Implementation of Ongoing Water & Sanitation Projects:
 - The Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) projects, State Water Grid initiative, and other sanitation programs require additional manpower for timely execution.
 - Engineer Assistants can play a vital role in supervising pipeline installation, infrastructure construction, and real-time monitoring of water distribution.
- 3. Grievance Redressal and Field Supervision:
 - Rural households frequently report water supply disruptions and sanitation issues, which require **prompt technical resolution**.
 - Engineer Assistants can provide **on-ground technical support** to efficiently address complaints and enhance service delivery.

To efficiently manage the increased workload and ensure uninterrupted rural drinking water supply, we propose the deputation of 3 to 5 Engineer Assistants per mandal as per the necessity.

In view of the above, we earnestly request your kind intervention to facilitate the immediate deputation of Engineer Assistants 3 to 5 Engineer Assistants per mandal to the RWS&S Department to assist AEE/AEs in effectively managing the summer water crisis and ongoing projects. This deputation arrangement will play a crucial role in mitigating operational challenges and ensuring uninterrupted drinking water supply to rural households.

We remain hopeful for your prompt consideration and a favourable decision on this pressing matter.
